

ISE Introduces Redesigned Web Site

NEW YORK, October 15, 2002 –ISE's web site now offers options traders even more options.

ISE Background

ISE pioneered electronic options trading in the U.S. Within 18-months of its May 26, 2000 launch, the Exchange became the third largest of five domestic options exchanges, a position that it has since enhanced by capturing the lead market share in its listings. During the 2002 third quarter, ISE dominated trading in its listed issues, capturing a 27% market share, or average daily volume of 671.531 contracts.

ISE is the only all-electronic U.S. options exchange, the first registered securities exchange approved by the Securities and Exchange Commission since 1973, and the first and only electronic options exchange in the global marketplace that has successfully integrated the intrinsic efficiencies of electronic trading with auction market principles.
